One of the North's leading Muslim Primary schools, Manchester Muslim Preparatory School has for the last three years been voted as the most outstanding Muslim Primary school in Northern England at the Global Peace and Unity event supported by Islam Channel.

A brief history

In 1991 a group of local Muslims in Manchester decided to provide Nursery education and the highest quality care within a uniquely Islamic environment. By the grace of Allah (SWT), in response to the success of this project, Manchester Muslim Preparatory School was opened in 1993 at 357 Wilmslow Road, Fallowfield. The school was then relocated in 1994 to the present premises in Withington, opposite the world famous 'Christie Hospital', Manchester.

Catering for a maximum of 192 pupils, the building has 8 fully equipped and well resourced classrooms, a P.E. hall/assembly area, library, computer suite, a multi-purpose room, a large playground and a purpose built play area for the younger children.

MMPS is run by the Manchester Islamic Educational Trust in conjunction with Manchester Islamic High School for Girls and Kassim Darwish Grammar School for Boys.

Mission statement

Our aim is to create a caring, warm atmosphere within which pupils can develop their full potential. Through the teaching and practice of Islam in the light of the Quran and Sunnah, we aim to develop a love for Allah (SWT) and confidence in their identity as young Muslims.

By providing varied and stimulating work, and setting achievable tasks and goals for every pupil, we acknowledge and actively encourage all abilities within the school. The Curriculum

At MMPS we follow the National curriculum for England and Wales and our pupils participate in the National SATs testing at the end of Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2. Our Key Stage 2 SATs results are as follows:

The curriculum is enhanced by a programme of Islamic Studies, including the teaching of the Quran which incorporates memorisation and recitation. Arabic is also taught as a separate language. From Year 1 onwards our pupils also have the option of learning French or Urdu as an additional language. Year 4 and Year 5 pupils enjoy Swimming lessons at a local Sports centre.

The school is registered with Sure Start thus enabling our Nursery pupils to access the Nursery education grant for 15 hours of funding per week.

Extra Curricular Activities

After school activities include an 'After school Quran class' and also a 'Sports Club' run by an outside agency. We also provide regular extra-curricular activity mornings on the last day of half term or term with activities such as baking, drama club, Spelling bee (spelling competition) glass painting, keep fit and many more!
